GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPLICANTS

- 1) In order to have a graduate education as a foreign student at Mugla Sıtkı Kocman University under the regulations of **International Students Application, Acceptance and Registration Terms and Conditions**, the candidates must have the status of international student. Applications for the following individuals will not be accepted as international students who:
- holds a Turkish Citizenship and completed all of the secondary education in Turkey or Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus,
 - holds a Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus citizenship (except the ones who completed their secondary education in Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus having GCE AL examination results and the ones who enrolled and completed education at college and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010 having GCE AL scores or will possibly have one of these results),
 - holds double citizenships, first of which is Turkish citizenship with birth which is defined at the article a, and act 2 (except the ones who satisfy the conditions in the article a, and act 4),
 - holds double citizenships, one of which is Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus citizenship (except the ones who completed their secondary education in Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus having GCE AL examination results and the ones who completed their secondary education at college and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010 having GCE AL scores or will possibly have one of these results),
 - holds Turkish citizenship or double citizenships, first of which is Turkish citizenship with birth which is defined at the article a, and act 2 and graduated from secondary schools as a part of the embassies in Turkey or at foreign secondary schools in Turkey

- 2) The candidates must have graduated from Undergraduate programs (B.Sc) or Master of science (M.Sc) programs. The application for Master of Science Programs requires an undergraduate degree and those applying for the Ph.D. programs must hold a M. Sc. degree.
- 3) The candidates must provide a language proficiency result at a required level to follow the education in the graduate programs either in Turkish or in English language.
- 4) The graduate applications of international students are evaluated according to the information given on the official documents provided by the applicants. In this evaluation process, the grade point average (GPA) of the graduation, foreign language proficiency score, the letter of intent and reference letters from the applicant's professors are used to decide for the acceptance of the candidates to the intended graduate program.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

(1) There is a certain limited number of the applications for international students for each graduate program as shown in the announcement. Applications will be taken on the dates indicated in the Academic Calendar of Muğla Sıtkı Koçman University and are evaluated by the academic committee of each graduate program. The decision of individual graduate programs will be finalized after the approval of Executive Committee of the Graduate School of Natural and Applied Sciences.

(2) Except for the graduate programs requiring higher GPA, the graduate point average (GPA) of applicants applying for the graduate programs of the master of science (M.Sc) and the doctor of philosophy (Ph.D.) must be **2.00** out of **4.0**.

(3) Except for the graduate programs requiring higher foreign language score, candidates who apply to the Ph.D. programs must have a score of at least 55 points from the language exam of YDS or YÖKDİL or equivalent score obtained from the foreign language exams recognized by the ÖSYM.

(4) In order to have an acceptance for the graduate programs indicated below, all international students who will apply to the master of science programs (w/thesis) of Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Civil Engineering, Geological Engineering, Mining Engineering, Bioinformatics and Metallurgy and Materials Engineering must have a score of at least 60 points from the language exams of YDS or YÖKDİL or an equivalent score obtained from the other internationally recognized foreign language exams approved by the ÖSYM. Alternatively, a language score of 65 points from the language exam of MÜDS will be accepted (please see the Article 5- (6) b) of the Graduate Educational Regulation of Muğla Sıtkı Koçman University).

(5) Candidates who will apply to the Ph.D. program of Bioinformatics, Electrical and Electronics Engineering and Mining Engineering must have at least 60 points from the language exam of YDS or YÖKDİL or an equivalent score obtained from the other internationally recognized foreign language exams approved by the ÖSYM.

(6) Candidates applying for the Master of Science program of Bioinformatics must have a B.Sc. degree in the fields of Sciences, Engineering and Medical and Life Sciences. For candidates applying for the Ph.D. program of the same department, a master of science degree in the fields of Sciences, Engineering and Medical and Life Sciences is required.

(7) Candidates applying for the Master of Science (M.Sc.) program of Civil Engineering Department must have a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering. Only the limited number of applicants interested in studying the indicated fields below to study Master of Science degree will be accepted to the graduate program of Ciivil Engineering as:

Mechanics – 1 student

Building Materials- 1 students

Hydraulics, Hydrology, Water Resources, GBS and Remote Sensing- 2 students

Hydraulic- 1 students

(8) Candidates applying for the Master of Science degree in **Statistics** must have an undergraduate degree in one of the fields of Mathematics, Econometrics, Industrial Engineering, Computer Engineering and Computer Science.

Candidates applying for the Ph.D. degree in **Statistics** must have a Master of Science degree in one of the fields of Mathematics, Econometrics, Industrial Engineering, Computer Engineering and Computer Science.

⁽⁹⁾ Candidates applying for the Master of science program in Mining Engineering (education in English language) and (education in Turkish language) must have an undergraduate degree in the fields of Mining Engineering or Mineral Processing Engineering.

⁽¹⁰⁾ Candidates applying for the Master of Science program in the Fisheries Engineering must have an undergraduate degree in the fields of Oceanography, Biology, Hydrobiology, Marine Biology and Diving as well as be fluent in writing and speaking in Turkish language.

Candidates applying for the Ph.D. program in the Fisheries Engineering must have a Master of Science degree in the fields of Oceanography, Biology, Hydrobiology, Marine Biology and Diving as well as be fluent in writing and speaking in Turkish language and English language having internationally accepted score of IBT equals to 72 and above or other equivalent internationally recognized scores accepted by the Higher Education Counsel of Turkey (YÖK).

Note: International students are only allowed to register and study a single graduate program in accordance with Article 35-6 of **the Other Provisions of the Graduate Educational Regulations of the Higher Educational Council of Turkey (YÖK)** published in the Official Gazette dated April 20, 2016 and numbered 29690.

APPLICATION AND EXAM DATES

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION: Pre-registration of applications will be made online. Pre-registration application documents will be uploaded to **Online Application Form**. Those candidates who cannot submit the originals of the documents during the final registration will lose their registration rights. The list of eligible candidates will be announced on the web page of the Graduate School of Natural and Applied Sciences after **17:30 on the day of December 13, 2019**.

- b) The copy of diploma (undergraduate diploma for master of science programs and master of science diploma for the Ph.D. programs),
- c) Official Transcript (undergraduate or M.Sc.transcript),
- d) The copy of Identity Card (a copy of your passport pages showing your identity information),
- e) One Passport Picture,
- f) Reference Letters from the academic professors of the applicant (at least one),
- g) CV and Letter of Intent (The letter must involve the academic purpose of the applicants and previous academic experiences about the graduate program he/she is applying.),


- h) If available, a Language Proficiency Score must be provided (It will be evaluated by the department according to the regulations of Mugla Sıtkı Koçman University),
- i) If available, 'Diploma Equivalency Certificate' showing the diploma earned in other countries is officially recognized by Higher Education Council of Turkey (YÖK). (please see: Mugla Sıtkı Kocman University, International Students Application, Acceptance and Registration Terms and Conditions, item 17/b),
- j) For the graduate programs with education given in Turkish language: please provide a copy of translation of Diploma and Transcript to Turkish language; For the graduate programs with education given in English language: please provide an official copy of translated Diploma and Transcript to English language approved by a Notary Public Office or an Embassy / the General Consulate of the Republic of Turkey.
