GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Candidates must be in International Student status in order to be able to study in graduate programs within the scope of the Directive regarding the Application, Admission and Registration Procedures of Muğla Sıtkı Koçman University.
- 2) Candidates must graduate from undergraduate / graduate programs of universities. Application to Master's programs can be made with a Bachelor's degree, while Ph.D. programs can be applied with a Master's degree.
- 3) Candidates must have a sufficient level of language knowledge to follow the education in Turkish-language programs. Candidates who certify that they have completed their education in a university teaching in Turkish are exempted from the Turkish Language exam. Apart from this, in order for the candidates accepted to the relevant program to start the courses:
 - a) Candidates who apply to the programs whose education language is Turkish should have at least B2 level language certificate,
 - **b**) Candidates who do not have this certificate are required to take at least 60 grades from the Turkish placement test to be held by the School of Foreign Languages.
- 4) Students who do not have Turkish language proficiency but are accepted to any postgraduate program are given a maximum of two semesters from the date of registration for Turkish language proficiency certificate, by the decision of the Graduate School Administrative Board. Students who do not submit their Turkish language proficiency certificate to the Institute within this period will be deregistered.
- 5) The evaluation of international students' Master and Ph.D. applications is made on the sent/submitted application documents. In the evaluation, it is decided whether the candidate will be admitted to the program within the announced quota considering the grade point average (GPA), language exam success grade, resume (CV) and references.
- 6) Candidates can apply to a maximum of 1 program within the announced quotas.

CALENDAR AND PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION

- 1) Applications for International Students for the Fall Semester of the 2021-2022 Academic Year will be made from the Online Application link in the announcement between 02-18 August 2021 and the requested documents will be uploaded to the system in PDF format. In case of missing documents uploaded to the system, applications will not be accepted.
- 2) Candidates who cannot submit the originals of the documents in the final registration will lose their right to register.
- 3) The list of candidates whose applications are accepted will be announced on the website of our Institute on August 31, 2021.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

For applications to graduate programs, the application form in the link specified by our Institute is filled and in addition to this form, the following documents are uploaded in PDF format:

- Undergraduate and/or graduate diploma translated into Turkish or English from Turkish Embassies/Consulates or certified diploma copy from the notary, a certificate
 of equivalence or Apostille for countries with Apostille side, and for not party to the Apostille the country's Foreign Ministry approval, for the candidates who are in
 their last semesters (yet without a diploma) an official document issued by their higher education institutions where they are studying, showing the date on which
 candidates will graduate.
- 2) Undergraduate/graduate transcript translated into Turkish or English by Turkey Embassies/Consulates or a notarized copy, the Apostille seal for countries with Apostille side, and for not party to the Apostille the approval of the country's Ministry of Foreign Affairs,
- 3) Photocopy of the identity document or passport related page,
- 4) 1 portrait (passport) photo,
- 5) One reference letter (from the lecturers in undergraduate education),
- 6) Resume (CV)
- 7) Document showing the foreign language/Turkish language proficiency, if available,
- 8) YÖK approved school recognition certificate, if available,
- 9) A portfolio containing the candidate's artistic works for fine arts and/or architecture.

REGISTRATION TIME AND IMPORTANT MATTERS REGARDING REGISTRATION

1) The registration of the candidates whose applications are accepted as principal or substitute will be made on the dates specified below.

- 2) Candidates who are accepted from the main list start their education by registering the courses, if they come with the documents required for registration within the first three weeks following the start of the courses according to the Academic Calendar. The documents required for registration will be included in the announcement regarding the application results.
- 3) However, if the candidates who are entitled to enroll from the reserve list and those who are entitled to enroll from the main list arrive in the 4th week of the semester or later in the 2021-2022 Academic Year Fall Semester, their registrations will be made, but the course enrollments and the start of education will be postponed to the 2021-2022 Academic Year Spring Semester.
